Dear Parent/Guardian,
Welcome back to a new school term.

A teachers strike has been confirmed for Thursday 18th January – Pupils will not be in school. Y11-14 should use this day to study for upcoming exams.

Staff day/study day has been moved from Wednesday 24th January to Monday 22nd January

<u>The Track 2 assessments</u> for Years 11-14 have also been moved and will now be from Thursday 25th to Tuesday 30th January . Exam timetables have been issued to student today and a copy is attached for your information.

- **Pupils must attend all sessions** where they have an exam or are with their teacher for coursework. Absences will be followed up by Head of Year/Assistant Head of Year.
- Revision sessions for all year groups can **ONLY** be taken in school or at home.
- Pupils are not allowed to hang around the town during the school day. Reports of pupils making nuisances of themselves will be severely dealt with by Head of Year.
- Year 11 pupils must remain on site for lunch if they are in school for session 2 and session 3.
- Year 12 pupils will be issued with an exam lunch pass that will allow them to go out to town for lunch. These must be shown to teacher on GATE Duty.
- A written report will go home for all pupils with the Track results. Underachievement will be followed up by Pastoral/Principal.
- The strike day (Thursday 18th) and Monday 22nd are both Revision Days at home.
