<u>The Track 2 assessments</u> for Years 11-14 from Thursday 25th to Tuesday 30th January. Exam timetables have been issued to students.

- Revision sessions for all year groups can ONLY be taken in school or at home.

- Year 12 pupils will be issued with an exam lunch pass that will allow them to go out to town for lunch. These must be shown to teacher on GATE Duty.
- A written report will go home for all pupils with the Track results. Underachievement will be followed up by Pastoral/Principal.
